The food pantry was used 338 times in February serving 1,398 individuals consisting of 588 children and 150 seniors.

Thank you to everyone who has donated to the Food Pantry. We are gratified by the continued generosity of our parish and the community. Heartfelt thanks to all the wonderful volunteers whose continued service enables the Food Pantry to operate.

The items listed below are requested for the Food Pantry as they are unavailable or rarely available from the Greater Chicago Food Depository. This is where 90% of the food distributed at the Food Pantry is purchased at or below cost or received free as USDA commodities. The other 10% of the food distributed comes from our own food drives and those done by other families, churches, companies and organizations. Cash donations are used to purchase needed items from the Greater Chicago Food Depository.

SNAP (food stamps) applications are done each Thursday from 10:00 – 3:30 pm. Please check at the food pantry for a list of needed documentation.

Volunteers are always needed to keep the Food Pantry running smoothly.
